Discussion Questions

- The Beast's influence grows stronger in this final book. How does the story portray the reality of spiritual deception?
- How can believers today guard their hearts and discern truth in a deceived world?

Hope in the Midst of Darkness

- Despite all odds, hope refuses to die. What scenes or characters gave you hope in the darkest moments of the book?
- How does this story help you hold on to hope in your own life?

Personal Reflection

- Several characters had to choose between loyalty to others and loyalty to God. Have you ever felt that tension in your own life? What did you learn from it?
- Are you willing to be bold with your testimony even when it's costly?
- What holds you back from sharing your faith more openly?
- · What might help you step forward?
